SFPUC Projects in City Streets

- **Renewal/Replacement Projects**
 - 15 miles of water and wastewater pipelines/year
 - Rate has tripled over last 5 years
 - Priority based on condition assessment and/or partnering opportunities
- **Capital Projects**
 - Water supply projects (groundwater, recycled water)
 - New water/sewer transmission pipelines
 - Storm water projects
 - Street lighting and electrical transmission/distribution
- **Installation of new water/sewer services**
- **Emergency Work**

SFPUC Noticing for Projects

- Procedures vary with type of project, but goals are consistent:
 - Maximize lead time
 - Explain importance of project to public
 - Act on any public concerns
- Methods: written notices, community meetings, web pages, social media on-site postings, door-to-door outreach.
- 24-hr notice for planned water service interruption.

Concluding remarks....

- Work in the public right of way has increased (public works and private utility projects)
- Coordination among city departments is active and has significantly reduced impacts to the public.
- All of the work is for the betterment of the city.
