[Minority Home Ownership] URGING THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANK OF SAN FRANCISCO TO CONDUCT A SPECIAL MEETING TO ADDRESS THE MINORITY HOME OWNERSHIP CRISIS IN

CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, According to the Greenlining Institute, between 1997 and 1996 in California, while conventional home loans to Latinos and African Americans increased 3.6 percent and 9.7 percent respectively, conventional home loans to Asians and whites increased 37 percent and 38 percent respectively; and,

WHEREAS, From 1994 through 1997, conventional home loans to African Americans and Latinos declined 15 percent while conventional home loans to whites increased by more than 40 percent; and,

WHEREAS, According to a report issued by the Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now, African Americans are more than twice as likely as whites to be rejected for a home loan and Latinos are 70 percent more likely than whites to be rejected for a home loan; and,

WHEREAS, The Greenlining Institute has asked the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco to conduct a special meeting of the chief executive officers of the largest lenders in California to discuss this crisis in minority home ownership; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco to conduct a special meeting to address the minority home ownership crisis in California; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board transmit a copy of this resolution to the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco.
