I am a queer, cisgender white woman, who has lived and worked in San Francisco for over 26 years. I live in District 10, on the edge of the Mission. I am familiar with, and comfortable representing, the broader needs of the LGBTQ communities in San Francisco, the needs of those living with and at greatest risk of HIV, and people who use drugs. I am an appreciative consumer of many of the types of entertainment and culture provided by San Francisco's diverse entertainment community.
I have been serving in this seat on the Entertainment Commission over the last year and am currently the elected Vice President of the Commission.

Business and/or professional experience:

My professional background is in public health, community planning, and policy advocacy. I currently work for the Drug Policy Alliance, leading our work in California and San Francisco on harm reduction, a public health approach to substance use, and access to substance use disorder treatment. My work has been focused on policy approaches to reduce the harms related to drugs, specifically overdose mortality and HIV transmissions. I helped bring the Club Health conference to San Francisco in 2013, to showcase San Francisco's innovations on the intersection of entertainment, public health, and harm reduction. I have focused on federal, state, and local public health policy and legislation throughout my career.

Civic Activities:

I have been an active member of a number of community planning groups, non-profit Boards of Directors, and other civic organizations in the 26 years I have lived in San Francisco. I am currently a member of the HIV Community Planning Council, which advises SFDPH on HIV services. I served for many years as a member and co-chair of the HIV Health Services Planning Council, the community planning body responsible for prioritizing and allocating federal HIV funds. I am an appointed member of the Cannabis State Legalization Task Force. I was the co-president of the Harvey Milk LGBT Democratic Club for two years and am a member of the Executive Board. I was one of the founders of the San Francisco Dyke March and a core member of the organizing committee until 2002. I have been honored to serve as a member of the Board of Directors for the Asian & Pacific Islander Wellness Center for six years, as well as the Board of Women Organized to Respond to Life-threatening Diseases (WORLD).

Charter, Section 4.117 (Prop F, November 2002 Election) and Administrative Code, Chapter 90 (Ordinance Nos. 164-02; 242-05; and 100-13)

Board Qualifications:

The Entertainment Commission shall consist of seven (7) members, comprised of three (3) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors and four (4) members nominated by the Mayor.

Each nomination by the Mayor shall be subject to approval by the Board of Supervisors and shall be the subject of a public hearing and vote within 60 days. If the Board of Supervisors fails to act on a mayoral nomination within 60 days from the date the nomination is transmitted to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, the nominee shall be deemed approved.

Of the four (4) members nominated by the Mayor:

- > One (1) member must represent the interests of City neighborhood associations or groups;
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of entertainment associations or groups;
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of the urban planning community; and
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of the law enforcement community.

Of the three (3) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors:

- > One (1) member must represent the interests of City neighborhood associations or groups;
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of entertainment associations or groups; and
- > One (1) member must represent the interests of the public health community.

To stagger the terms, the initial appointments to the commission shall be as follows: the Mayor

nominate two members to serve terms of four years, one member to serve a term of three years and one member to serve a term of two years. Of the three remaining members, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint one member to serve a term of four years, one member to serve a term of three years and one member to serve a term of two years. All terms of initial appointees to the commission shall be deemed to commence upon the same date which shall be the date upon which the last of the seven initial appointees assumes office. Thereafter, all appointments and reappointments shall be for a term of four years.

The Entertainment Commission shall: 1) assist entertainment organizers and operators to apply for necessary permits; 2) promote responsible conduct; 3) promote the City's entertainment industry; 4) promote the use of City facilities; 5) foster harm reduction policies; 6) develop "good neighbor policies"; 7) mediate disputes between persons affected by entertainment events and establishments and the operators of such establishments; 8) issue entertainment related permits; 9) plan and coordinate City services for major events; and 10) provide information regarding venues and services appropriate for events and functions ancillary to conventions.

Reports: Prepare and submit to the Mayor and Board of Supervisors: 1) within one year from July 6, 2002, and not less than five years thereafter, a report analyzing the Commission's effectiveness; 2) an annual report by March 1st regarding its activities for the preceding year; and 3) within one year from July 6, 2002, and annually thereafter, a report analyzing fee revenue.
