LIBRARY STAFF EDUCATION PROGRAM AS PART OF THE FEDERAL LIBRARY  
SERVICES AND TECHNOLOGY ACT (LSTA). FUNDS WILL BE USED TO  
REIMBURSE TUITION EXPENSES OF LIBRARY EMPLOYEES PURSUING A DEGREE  
OR CERTIFICATE IN LIBRARY SCIENCE AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION. EMPLOYEES PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM APPLIED TO, AND  
WERE SELECTED BY, THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, The California State Library's Public Library Staff Education Program is  
dedicated to providing tuition reimbursement for library staff pursuing a degree or certification in  
Library Science, and

WHEREAS, five non-professional employees of San Francisco Public Library applied to  
the California State Library to participate and receive specific tuition reimbursement amounts  
and were accepted into the program, and


WHEREAS, The California State Library has awarded \$12,014 to San Francisco Public  
Library to reimburse the student/employees for Fall 2000, Spring 2001, and Summer 2001  
Tuition fees, and an additional sum of \$1,201 to cover indirect costs, and


WHEREAS, Student/employees will provide official transcripts and registration fee


