3	Ordinance amending San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.170 to provide that
4	all applications submitted by the City for federal, State, or other grants requesting
5	funding for fifty thousand dollars or more for any project or program shall be subject to
6	approval by the Board of Supervisors by resolution.

10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
12	Section 10.170, to read as follows:
13	Sec. 10.170. Grant – Application Procedure.
14	Applications for federal, State, or other grants involving requesting funding for less than
15	fifty thousand dollars for any project or program shall be filed on behalf of a department upon
16	the approval by the department head.
17	Applications for federal, State, or other grants requesting funding for fifty thousand dollars or
18	more for any project or program is subject to the approval by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
19	The request for approval of a grant application must include, and shall be processed, in the following
20	<u>manner:</u>
21	(a) A proposed resolution approving the grant application signed by the department head
22	and the Mayor or his or her designee;
23	(b) A completed "Grant Application Information Form" provided by the Clerk of the Board
24	indicating the grant sought, applicable deadlines, details of the grant, and the purpose(s) for which the
25	grant will be utilized;

1	(c) The resolution shall be introduced, referred to the appropriate committee, and submitted
2	for review by the Budget Analyst;
3	(d) All resolutions shall be calendared as consent items for consideration by the assigned
4	<u>committee.</u>
5	(e) When approval of a grant application must be granted within three weeks in order for
6	the application to be timely submitted, the department may submit the grant application and
7	retroactively apply to the Board for approval. The retroactive approval process shall be as follows:
8	(1) The department shall submit the proposed resolution approving the grant application
9	signed by the department head and the Mayor or his or her designee, completed "Grant Application
10	Information Form", and cover letter indicating the necessity and reason for retroactive approval to the
11	Clerk's Office for the Board of Supervisors;
12	(2) The resolution shall be introduced, referred to the appropriate committee, and submitted
13	for review by the Budget Analyst;
14	(3) All resolutions shall be calendared as consent items for consideration by the assigned
15	<u>committee.</u>
