14 Children's Hospital) in November 1997; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Martin Diamond has been a member of the Community Advisory  
17 Committee on Violence Prevention from 1995 through 1998 and has taken community  
18 violence prevention as a personal cause, working on projects such as the 1998 community  
19 gun exchange and bringing violence prevention to the attention of health care facilities  
20 throughout the Bay Area; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Martin Diamond has demonstrated and maintained a family  
23 atmosphere at UCSF Mount Zion Medical Center throughout his tenure; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Martin Diamond will be sorely missed by his colleagues at the


