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8	WHEREAS, In each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the official
9	newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to Administrative Code,
10	Sections 2.80-1 and 2.81; and
11	WHEREAS, Based on the anticipated date of approval of this Resolution, and to
12	prevent the interruption of services to City Departments, the Office of Contract Administration
13	has executed a modification to the existing San Francisco Chronicle Agreement. The San
14	Francisco Chronicle Agreement dated July 1, 2013, has been extended by one month, or unt
15	this Resolution has been adopted and signed, subject to ratification by the Board; now,
16	therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED, That The Examiner, a newspaper of general circulation published in the
18	City and County of San Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic news and
19	intelligence of a general character, having a bona fide circulation of at least 50,000 copies pe
20	calendar week, printed in the City, is hereby designated as an official newspaper of the City
21	and County of San Francisco for the publication of all official advertising of the City and
22	County for FY2014-2015 starting on the effective date of this Resolution through June 30,
23	2015; and, be it
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Office of Contract Administration is hereby
25	authorized to enter into a contract with The Examiner and said contract(s) must be in

1	accordance with all the contracting requirements of the City and County of San Francisco;
2	and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board hereby approves and ratifies the modification
4	extending the term of the previous contract with San Francisco Chronicle as executed by the
5	Office of Contract Administration, copies of which are contained in Board of Supervisor's File
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
