

1 [Airport Purchase of Explosive Detection Baggage Inspection Machines for the New  
2 International Terminal - \$19,300,000]

3 **Resolution approving the sole source purchase order agreement for 11 explosive**  
4 **detection baggage inspection machines for the new International Terminal between**  
5 **InVision Technologies, Inc. and the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and**  
6 **through its Purchasing Department and its Airport Commission.**

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8 WHEREAS, The new Federal Aviation and Transportation Security Act requires all  
9 checked baggage to be screened for explosives; and

10 WHEREAS, San Francisco International Airport (The "Airport") is responsible for the  
11 baggage inspection system in the new International Terminal; and

12 WHEREAS, To comply with the new Security Act, the Airport will need to purchase 11  
13 explosive detection baggage inspection machines for the new International Terminal; and

14 WHEREAS, The new machines will replace the existing Stage 1 x-ray machines and  
15 are available only from InVision Technologies, Inc.; and

16 WHEREAS, The estimated purchase cost is \$19.3 million, and

17 WHEREAS, On January 22, 2002, the Airport Commission approved the purchase of  
18 the machines. A copy of the Airport Commission Resolution, the pertinent section of the  
19 Federal Aviation and Transportation Security Act, the sole source justification, and Federal  
20 reimbursable agreement letter are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File  
21 No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as set forth fully herein;  
22 now, therefore be it

23 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Purchase Order  
24 Agreement on a sole course basis for 11 explosive detection baggage inspection machines in  
25 the new International Terminal between InVision Technologies, Inc. and the City and County

1 of San Francisco, acting by and through its Purchasing Department and its Airport  
2 Commission, all contingent upon the airport Director’s negotiation and execution of an  
3 agreement with the Federal Government to reimburse the Airport for the equipment purchase;  
4 and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That this approval request is in accordance with Charter  
6 Section 9.118 for Contract Purchases in excess of \$10 million.

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
