

Amendment of the Whole In Committee- 1/28/08

1 [Urging the Recreation and Park Commission to enter a grant agreement with a community  
2 non-profit to enable the organization to develop a long-term funding and operational plan for a  
community-based youth and teen arts program.

3 **Resolution urging the Recreation and Park Commission to enter a grant agreement**  
4 **with a community non-profit to enable the organization to develop a long-term funding**  
5 **and operational plan for a community-based youth and teen arts program in the**  
6 **Geneva Office Building.**

8 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 193-04 transferred jurisdiction over the Geneva Office  
9 Building and Powerhouse (the “Building”) from the San Francisco Municipal Transportation  
10 Authority to the Recreation and Parks Department (the “Department”); and,

11 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors effectuated this transfer to preserve the Geneva  
12 Office Building and for the adaptive re-use of the Building as a new space for youth and teen  
13 arts; and,

14 WHEREAS, Since 2003, the City has appropriated funds to the Department for repairs  
15 and improvements to the building, now it is the Department’s intention to locate a community-  
16 based non-profit that has the capacity to develop and operate this facility as a community run  
17 youth and teen arts center; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Recreation and Park  
20 Commission to enter into a grant agreement with a community based non-profit organization  
21 to conduct community outreach, develop a long-term funding strategy and develop the  
22 capacity to eventually become a candidate for an agreement with the City in which the  
23 organization would operate a community-based youth and teen arts program in the building.
