3 **Resolution proclaiming October 2003 “Potrero Hill Month” in the City and County of**  
4 **San Francisco.**

6 WHEREAS, The Potrero Hill neighborhood is known for its diversity, from family  
7 homes and warehouses to theaters and nightclubs, from design showrooms and thriving  
8 commercial districts to Dogpatch and the waterfront; and

9 WHEREAS, The Potrero Hill neighborhood is also notable for its high level of civic  
10 awareness and involvement with tireless efforts from organizations like the Potrero Boosters  
11 and the Potrero Hill Association of Merchants and Businesses; and,

12 WHEREAS, Several community events will be held throughout the month of October  
13 on Potrero Hill, including a cleanup at the Enola D. Maxwell Middle School of the Arts, the  
14 Potrero Hill Neighborhood House Festival, and the San Francisco Community Power  
15 Cooperative Treasure Trek on October 18 and Farley’s Halloween Pet Parade on October 25;

17 WHEREAS, The unique and popular Potrero Hill History Night, presented by the  
18 Merchants Association and the Potrero Hill Archives Project, will be held Saturday, October  
19 18 at the Enola D. Maxwell Middle School; and,

20 WHEREAS, The purpose of the Potrero Hill History Night is to preserve our  
21 understanding of this historic district; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors proclaims October 2003  
23 “Potrero Hill Month” in the City and County of San Francisco.
