It is further the intent of this Section to improve the capacity of the Municipal Transportation Agency and the Department of Public Works to collaborate and utilize the

strengths and efficiencies of each department to the greatest extent possible to ensure that projects supporting Vision Zero are completed expeditiously.

(b) The Municipal Transportation Agency and the Department of Public Works are authorized to enter into and/or amend any contract for any Public Work or Improvement, including any professional services for a Public Work or Improvement, without adherence to the requirements of this Chapter 6, Administrative Code Chapter 14B, Labor and Employment Code Article 131, and the Environment Code; provided, however, that the Department Head has determined in writing that the Public Work or Improvement is for the construction, repair, or improvement of public facilities with a primary purpose of implementing Vision Zero.

(c) This Section 6.78 shall expire by operation of law three years from its effective date. Upon expiration of this Section 6.78, the City Attorney is authorized to cause this Section to be removed from the Administrative Code.
