14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

16 Section 1. Article IV of Chapter 6 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by
 17 adding Section 6.78, to read as follows:

18 **SEC 6.78. PUBLIC WORKS ADDRESSING VISION ZERO.**

19 *(a) In 2014, the City adopted Vision Zero—a plan to eliminate traffic deaths and reduce severe*
 20 *traffic injuries—as a citywide commitment to build better and safer streets, educate the public on traffic*
 21 *safety, enforce traffic laws, and adopt policy changes that save lives. The intent of this Section 6.78 is*
 22 *to strengthen Vision Zero by expediting the procurement of professional design, construction, and other*
 23 *services supporting Vision Zero. It is further the intent of this Section to improve the capacity of the*
 24 *Municipal Transportation Agency and the Department of Public Works to collaborate and utilize the*

2 supporting Vision Zero are completed expeditiously.

3 (b) The Municipal Transportation Agency and the Department of Public Works are authorized
4 to enter into and/or amend any contract for any Public Work or Improvement, including any
5 professional services for a Public Work or Improvement, without adherence to the requirements of this
6 Chapter 6, Administrative Code Chapter 14B, Labor and Employment Code Article 131, and the
7 Environment Code; provided, however, that the Department Head has determined in writing that the
8 Public Work or Improvement is for the construction, repair, or improvement of public facilities with a
9 primary purpose of implementing Vision Zero.

10 (c) This Section 6.78 shall expire by operation of law three years from its effective date. Upon
11 expiration of this Section 6.78, the City Attorney is authorized to cause this Section to be removed from
12 the Administrative Code.

13
14 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
15 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
16 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
17 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
