

1 [Zoning - Extension of Planning Commission Review Period.]

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3 **Resolution extending the prescribed time within which the planning commission may**
4 **render its decision on a proposed ordinance to amend the planning code to require**
5 **that all new commercial buildings and commercial buildings with major renovations**
6 **contain parking spaces for bicycles proportionate to and in accordance with such**
7 **building's square footage and primary use.**

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9 WHEREAS, On March 19, 2001, the Board of Supervisors initiated the process to
10 amend the San Francisco Planning Code, when the Honorable Mark Leno introduced a
11 proposed ordinance to require that all new commercial buildings and commercial buildings
12 with major renovations contain parking spaces for bicycles proportionate to and in accordance
13 with such building's square footage and primary use, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk
14 of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001208 and File No. 010488, and,

15 WHEREAS, On March 22, 2001, the proposed ordinance was referred to the Planning
16 Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by
18 resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its
19 decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code initiated by the Board of
20 Supervisors; and,

21 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has requested additional time to review the
22 proposed ordinance; and,

23 WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning
24 Commission additional time to review the proposed ordinance and render its decision; now,
25 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That by this resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time
2 within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed ordinance to
3 require that all new commercial buildings and commercial buildings with major renovations
4 contain parking spaces for bicycles proportionate to and in accordance with such building's
5 square footage and primary use, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
6 Supervisors in File No. 010488, for an additional forty-five days, or until August 3, 2001.
