4 **Resolution Proclaiming the San Francisco Local of the American Postal Workers**
5 **Union, AFL-CIO, for one hundred years of representing the working postal**
6 **men and women of San Francisco.**

8 WHEREAS, On December 4, 1906, the San Francisco Local of the American Postal
9 Workers Union, AFL-CIO, became the second local chartered under the authority of the
10 constitution and by-laws of the national Federation of Postal Clerks; and,

11 WHEREAS, This was but three months after that parent union itself was organized in the
12 American Federation of Labor on August 27, 1906; and,

13 WHEREAS, For one hundred years the San Francisco Local, also known as Local 2, has
14 fought for every member to be respected as a human being; and,

15 WHEREAS, It has also fought for every member to be respected as a brother or sister in
16 the Union and participate in Union activities; and,

17 WHEREAS, Local 2 has faithfully protected every member's right to seek any office and
18 vote in the Union as well as support the candidate of their choice; and,

19 WHEREAS, It promoted for its members to have a right to be secure in their basic
20 rights without fear of political, economic, physical or psychological intimidation; and,

21 WHEREAS, consistently sought for its members to have a right to a fair trail in union
22 matters with representation of their choice and proper appeal procedures; and,

23 WHEREAS, Local 2 fought for its members to have freedom of speech and the right to be
24 heard and listen, and enjoy the freedom of the press; and,

25 WHEREAS, Local 2 has fought to secure safe and healthy work environment, better
