3 **Resolution calling for the implementation of the pilot program for the Environmentally**
4 **Preferable Purchasing Program (EP3).**

6 WHEREAS, Chapter 21F of the San Francisco Administrative Code established the
7 San Francisco Environmentally Preferable Purchasing Program (EP3) to determine the
8 effectiveness of minimizing the City's purchase of chemicals used in janitorial services, fleet
9 maintenance, and building maintenance and replacing them with alternatives that pose less
10 health and environmental risks; and

11 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Chapter 21F, the Solid Waste Management Program as Lead
12 Department, has conducted and prepared an assessment report on the current City usage
13 and a pilot program plan with recommendations for implementation, both of which have been
14 presented to the Commission on the Environment; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Commission on the Environment has approved the Pilot Program
16 Plan prepared by the Solid Waste Management Program; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco,
18 calls for the implementation of the EP3 Pilot program by the Solid Waste Management
19 Program beginning in January, 2001 and ending June, 2002.
