5 Americans face, growing up one of 13 children in a poor African American Family in
6 the Midwest; and,

8 WHEREAS, An Information Technology Association of America (ITAA) task
9 force report states that although African Americans account for 10% of the overall
10 workforce, they make up only 5% of computer programmers; similarly, although
11 Hispanics account for 9% of the overall workforce, they make up only 4% of
12 computer programmers; and,

14 WHEREAS, Bob Knowling, Jr., CEO of Covad Communications Group Inc.,
15 and Chair of the Digital Opportunity Initiative, is helping to bridge this digital divide;

18 WHEREAS, Bob Knowling, Jr. has developed a nationwide internship program
19 designed to steer African American, Hispanic, and Native American students into
20 technology careers; and

22 WHEREAS, Bob Knowling, Jr. has already obtained the commitment of 10
23 companies to create paid summer and year long internships; and,

25 WHEREAS, The internship program will give students hands-on experience in
the technical, financial, sales, and marketing aspects of the company; now, therefore
be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
2 Francisco extends its highest commendation to CEO Bob Knowling, Jr. for helping
3 minorities enter the technology workforce.
