

1 [Accept Expend Grant - State Department of Boating and Waterways - \$65,000]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Police Department to retroactively accept and expend a**  
4 **grant in the amount of \$65,000 from the California State Department of Boating and**  
5 **Waterways for a Boating Safety and Enforcement Grant to purchase equipment for the**  
6 **Marine Unit.**

8 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department applied for and was awarded  
9 \$65,000 in funding from the California State Department of Boating and Waterways for a  
10 Boating and Safety Enforcement grant; and

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to support enforcement activities through the  
12 removal and replacement of electrical, exhaust, running gear, and interior insulation on board  
13 the Marine 1 Police Boat; and

14 WHEREAS, The award period is from October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS, The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs; and

17 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department is seeking retroactive approval  
18 because it did not receive the grant award until September 27, 2010; and

19 WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an  
20 amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now therefore be it

21 RESOLVED The City and County of San Francisco is authorized to retroactively accept  
22 and expend a grant from the California State Department of Boating and Waterways in the  
23 amount of \$65,000; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
25 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

1           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police, or his designee, is authorized to  
2 enter into the agreement on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco.
