4 **Ordinance authorizing settlement of two related lawsuits filed by Park Hotels & Resorts**
5 **Inc. et al. against the City and County of San Francisco concerning the real property**
6 **located at 555 North Point (Assessor's Parcel Block No. 0029, Lot No. 007) (the**
7 **"Subject Property") for a stipulated assessed value of the Subject Property of**
8 **\$139,800,000 as of September 17, 2019, contingent upon the Assessment Appeals**
9 **Board's approval, and a refund of \$983,430 plus statutory interest; the first lawsuit was**
10 **filed on August 7, 2023, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-23-608156;**
11 **entitled Park Hotels & Resorts Inc., et al. v. City and County of San Francisco; the**
12 **second lawsuit was filed on June 27, 2023, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No.**
13 **CGC-23-607311; entitled Park Hotels & Resorts Inc. v. City and County of San**
14 **Francisco, et al.; the lawsuits involve the assessed value of the Subject Property for**
15 **property tax purposes as of the September 17, 2019 change in ownership date and a**
16 **transfer tax refund; and repealing Ordinance No. 260-24, which authorized a prior**
17 **settlement of these lawsuits.**

19 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

20
21 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
22 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Park Hotels & Resorts Inc., et al. v.
23 City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-23-608156,
24 for a stipulated assessed value of the real property located at 555 North Point, San Francisco,

1 CA (APN 0029-007) of \$139,800,000 as of September 17, 2019, contingent upon the
2 Assessment Appeals Board's approval;

4 Section 2. The action in Section 1 was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on
5 August 7, 2023, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Park Hotels and Resorts
6 Inc., a Delaware Corporation, Park Intermediate Holdings LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability
7 Company, CHSP Fisherman Wharf LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability Company, and CHSP
8 TRS Fisherman Wharf LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability Company, Plaintiffs; and City and
9 County of San Francisco, Defendant.

11 Section 3. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
12 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Park Hotels & Resorts Inc., et al. v.
13 City and County of San Francisco, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-23-
14 607311, for the payment of \$983,430, plus statutory interest. The lawsuit involves a transfer
15 tax refund.
16

17 Section 4. The action in Section 3 was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on
18 June 27, 2023, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Park Hotels and Resorts
19 Inc., a Delaware Corporation, Park Intermediate Holdings LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability
20 Company, and CHSP Fisherman Wharf LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability Company, Plaintiffs;
21 and City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco Assessor-Recorder, San Francisco
22 Controller, San Francisco Board of Supervisors, San Francisco Treasurer, San Francisco Tax
23 Collector, and Does 1-10, Defendants.

Section 5. Ordinance No. 260-24 approved a prior settlement with the same parties to resolve the actions identified in Sections 1 and 3. Ordinance No. 260-24 became effective on November 14, 2024, but the City has not yet implemented the settlement authorized by that ordinance. The settlement authorized by Sections 1 and 3 of this ordinance supersedes the prior settlement. Accordingly, Ordinance No. 260-24 is hereby repealed.
