

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - California Victim Compensation Board - Compensation for
2 Crime Victims - \$2,164,014]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$2,164,014 from the California Victim Compensation**
5 **Board for a project entitled “Joint Powers Agreement” for the period July 1, 2018, to**
6 **June 30, 2021.**

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, Office of the District Attorney
9 desires to enter into an agreement with the California Victim Compensation Board in
10 accordance with Government Code, Section 13838 for the purpose of assisting victims and
11 witnesses with compensation claims; and

12 WHEREAS, Funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that
13 would, in the absence of California Victim Compensation Board Programs, be made available
14 to support the assistance of victims and witnesses of crime; and

15 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded “G” in the District
16 Attorney’s budget; and

17 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance
18 (ASO); and

19 WHEREAS, The grant budget does not include provision for indirect costs; now,
20 therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the District
22 Attorney to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San
23 Francisco, a grant from the California Victim Compensation Board to continue the Joint
24 Powers Agreement in the amount of \$2,164,014 to assist victims of crime.
