

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 **APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO**  
3 **REPLACE THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE SEWER ON HARRISON STREET FROM**  
4 **5<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND TO MODIFY THE EXISTING MERLIN-MORRIS PUMP**  
5 **STATION.**

6 **WHEREAS**, On July 13, 1998 PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency condition on  
7 Harrison Street from 5th Street to 6th Street; and

8 **WHEREAS**, The existing sewer was severely sagging and causing numerous backflow problems,  
9 and immediate replacement was required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property of the  
10 Citizens of San Francisco; and

11 **WHEREAS**, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract  
12 No. CW-150E, "Harrison Street Emergency Sewer Replacement" to construct approximately 457 linear  
13 feet of 16-inch diameter PEP sewer alongside the existing 12-inch diameter VCP sewer on Harrison  
14 Street from 5th Street to 6th Street and to modify the existing Merlin-Morris Pump Station to relieve the  
15 backflow situation; and

16 **WHEREAS**, The Contractor, Troy/Trinet Construction-JV, began the emergency work on  
17 October 1, 1998 and is expected to complete the work in April 1999 after the delivery of various pump  
18 station components from the manufacturer; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not  
20 established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water Program  
21 contracts; and

22 **WHEREAS**, The cost of the project is projected to be \$599,077, of which \$504,077 is for the  
23 construction contract. Funds are available from the Repair and Replacement Fund (Fund 5C/CPF/R&R,  
24 FAMIS Project No. CENRNR839, Job Order No. 1218N); and

25 **WHEREAS**, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30

1 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an  
2 emergency; now, therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the  
4 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on Harrison Street from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to 6<sup>th</sup>  
5 Street and to modify the existing Merlin-Morris Pump Station to prevent further backflow problems.




