13	The rates for parking meters in Parking Meter Area Number One shall be as follows:			
14	(a) A five-cent piece (nickel) shall allow a parking time period of one and one half-			
15	minutes following the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of five-cent pieces may be			
16	repeated for a like period of time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been			
17	expended; or			
18	(b) A ten-cent piece (dime) shall allow a parking time period of three minutes following			
19	the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of ten-cent pieces may be repeated for a like			
20	period of time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended; or			
21	(c) A twenty-five cent piece (quarter) shall allow a parking time period of seven and one-			
22	half minutes following the deposit of such coin, and such deposit of quarters may be repeated			
23	for a like period of time until the maximum time of the parking meter has been expended.
