

1 [Resolution Expanding the Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task Force]

3 **Resolution expanding the Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task Force and re-defining**
4 **the Task Force's quorum.**

6 WHEREAS, On December 1st, 2004, the Board of Supervisors passed Resolution
7 #041359 establishing a 22 member Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task Force; and,

8 WHEREAS, Since that time the Task Force has been meeting regularly; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Task Force has recommended that their composition be expanded to
10 include the following four seats: (1) An appointee of the Director of the Department of Public
11 Health; (2) A person with disabilities; (3) A resident of SoMa West; and (4) a person
12 representing the interests of the homeless; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Task Force has recommended that the quorum of the Task Force be
14 re-defined; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors add the following four seats to the 22 member
16 Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task Force: (1) an appointee of the Director of the
17 Department of Public Health; (2) a person with a disability; (3) a resident of the area defined
18 as 'SoMa West' by the Planning Department, and (4) a person representing the interests of
19 homeless individuals; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the quorum of the Task Force shall be re-defined as a
21 majority of sitting members.
