AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO IMPLEMENT A DRUG ABATEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSES OF APPLYING FOR FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD JULY 1, 1998 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1999.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to undertake a certain project designated the San Francisco Drug Abatement Program to be funded in part from funds made available through the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988 for the Anti-Drug Abuse Program administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (hereafter "OCJP"); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Director of the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council in coordination with the District Attorney, Chief of Police, Sheriff, Chief Adult and Juvenile Probation Officers, and the Public Defender is authorized to develop an Anti-Drug Abuse Program for purposes of applying for funds made available by OCJP; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Application and pending Grant Award Agreements for anti-drug abuse purposes including any extensions or amendments thereof; and,

IT IS AGREED, That there are no matching funds required for the project under the pending Anti-Drug Abuse Program and the rules and regulations of OCJP; and,

IT IS AGREED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the pending Grant Award Agreements, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and,

IT IS AGREED, There are no indirect costs to the City and County of San Francisco included in the budgets submitted with the grant application to OCJP; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
