15 coordination with the District Attorney, Chief of Police, Sheriff, Chief Adult and Juvenile
16 Probation Officers, and the Public Defender is authorized to develop an Anti-Drug Abuse
17 Program for purposes of applying for funds made available by OCJP; and, be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council is authorized
19 to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant
20 Application and pending Grant Award Agreements for anti-drug abuse purposes
21 including any extensions or amendments thereof; and,
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23 IT IS AGREED, That there are no matching funds required for the project under
24 the pending Anti-Drug Abuse Program and the rules and regulations of OCJP; and,
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1 IT IS AGREED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the pending
2 Grant Award Agreements, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the
3 responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California
4 and OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and,

5 IT IS AGREED, There are no indirect costs to the City and County of San
6 Francisco included in the budgets submitted with the grant application to OCJP; and, be


8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used
