[Gender Parity in Appointments]

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO ENSURE GENDER PARITY IN APPOINTMENTS

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Commission on the Status of Women issued a final report in October, 1998, entitled "Gender Parity," a compilation of two previous reports issued in December, 1997, and May, 1998, to the Mayor's Office and the Board of Supervisors, respectively; and,

WHEREAS, Although the Commission found that many boards, commissions, committees and departments have strong female leadership, some inequities which need to be addressed were also identified; and,

WHEREAS, The Commission found that although the numbers of women appointed to boards, commissions, and committees reflect a nearly equal ratio of women to men, upon further analysis of the numbers it was apparent that women predominantly gain appointments to bodies that handle traditionally female issues, such as child and elder care, juvenile correction and youth issues; and,

WHEREAS, Although the bodies that primarily address caretaking issues do conduct vital work, they also tend to be less economically viable, which yields women less financial influence within the City and County of San Francisco; and,

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors commends the diligence by the Commission on the Status of Women to ensure that women are represented and continue to gain leadership positions; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco should continue to make it a goal to support women in all leadership positions; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That more women should be appointed to bodies that are traditionally held my men, particularly those which hold greater financial authority within the City and County government; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That men should be provided with the opportunity to serve on bodies "traditionally" regarded as women's issues; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That there should be consultation at the Rules Committee regarding proposed appointments to increase gender parity on leadership bodies.
