12 WHEREAS, Tens of thousands of people were killed outright, and
13 hundreds of thousands more are injured, homeless and at grave risk of
14 disease and starvation; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco expresses
16 the deepest sympathy for the people of Honduras, Nicaragua, El
17 Salvador and Guatemala for the devastating losses caused by hurricane
18 Mitch; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the people
20 of San Francisco to aid in relief efforts to those countries.




