3 **Motion appointing Laura Guzman, term ending October 21, 2015, to the Local Homeless**  
4 **Coordinating Board, residency requirement waived.**

6 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does  
7 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Local  
8 Homeless Coordinating Board, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. 827-97 and  
9 Resolution No. 926-99, for the term specified:

10 Laura Guzman (residency requirement waived,) seat 1, succeeding herself, term  
11 expired, must be a member of the disabled community, for the unexpired portion of a four-  
12 year term ending October 21, 2015.

13 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 14 1. The membership of the Local Homeless Coordinating Board has a goal to be  
15 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 16 2. Applicant Laura Guzman, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with  
17 experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Local Homeless Coordinating  
18 Board.
- 19 3. The Local Homeless Coordinating Board has attempted to fill the position, for which  
20 Laura Guzman was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who  
21 has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so  
22 at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Laura Guzman is qualified to  
23 serve on the Local Homeless Coordinating Board.
- 24 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
25 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the
