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3 **Ordinance amending San Francisco Administrative Code Section 16.93-2 to include**  
4 **Donor Choice as an option for employee contributions during the Annual Joint**  
5 **Fundraising Drive.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Cod is hereby amended by amending  
11 Section 16.93-2, to read as follows:

12 **SEC. 16.93-2. SELECTION OF AGENCIES ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE**  
13 **ANNUAL JOINT FUNDRAISING DRIVE.**

14 Participation shall be limited to (1) any Mayor's fund which is created to further social  
15 causes, those funds being the Mayor's Youth Fund, the Mayor's Homeless Fund, and the  
16 Mayor's Youth Employment Summer Program, (2) the Donor Choice option as provided in  
17 subsection (f), and (3) ~~to~~ all federated agencies that meet the following criteria set forth in  
18 subsections (a) through (e), as determined by the Board of Supervisors:

19 (a) An eligible charitable agency must be a federated agency representing 10 or  
20 more charitable organizations, of which at least 50 percent shall represent organizations  
21 located in the counties of San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Alameda, Contra Costa,  
22 and Marin.

23 (b) The federated agency or Mayor's fund must certify to the Board of Supervisors  
24 that the Federal Internal Revenue Service has determined that contributions to all of the  
25 represented charitable organizations or Mayor's funds are tax deductible.

1 (c) The federated agency must have been in existence with 10 or more qualified  
2 charities for at least one year prior to the date of application and provide satisfactory evidence  
3 to that effect at the time of filing an application with the Board. Mayor's funds shall submit their  
4 most recent financial statement to the Board of Supervisors on an annual basis.

5 (d) The federated agency must submit its most recent certified audit at the time of  
6 filing an application with the Board.

7 (e) Agencies that wish to participate in the Annual Drive are required to submit  
8 applications to the Board of Supervisors that include all information that may be relevant to  
9 the criteria listed in this Section.

10 (f) Employees may designate any tax exempt charity of their choice to receive  
11 contributions, which option shall be known as Donor Choice.
