10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:


11 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to settle the action entitled "Ki-Man

14 withheld from three City public work contract balances pursuant to the assessment of
15 prevailing wage violations by the City's Office of Labor Standards Enforcement against Jin
16 Construction & Electric Co.
