4	beverage control license from 490 Post Street to 615-7 th Street (District 6), to

6	convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San
7	Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and
8	Professions Code, with conditions.

10	WHEREAS, Harold Hoogasian is seeking transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general
11	alcoholic beverage control license for dba "Hoogasian Flowers, Inc." located at 615-7 th
12	Street; and,
13	WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
14	zoned; and,
15	WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license
16	application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
18	and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
19	Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 21
20	off-sale general alcoholic beverage control license from 490 Post Street to 615-7 th
21	Street for Harold Hoogasian for dba "Hoogasian Flowers, Inc.", will serve the public
22	convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.
23	Conditions: (1) Sales and service of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only
24	between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. each day of the week; (2) Beer, malt
25	beverages, and wine coolers in containers of 16 oz. or less cannot be sold by single

containers, but must be sold in manufactured pre-packed multi-unit quantities; (3) The sales of beer or malt beverages in quantities of guarts, 22 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited. No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than six per sale; (4) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles; (5) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; (6) The entrance/exit which faces Gilbert Street shall be used for employees only and not the general public; (7) No distilled spirits shall be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 325 ml with the exception of 50 ml bottles which shall be sold in gift baskets; (8) The sale of alcoholic beverages shall be incidental to the sale of flowers and/or gift items.
