9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	Section 1. The San Francisco Municipal Elections Code is hereby amended by adding
11	Section 335, to read as follows:
12	SEC. 335. CIRCULATOR IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS
13	Every person is guilty of an misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500, who,
14	circulating, as a principal or agent, or having charge or control of the circulation of, or obtaining
15	signatures to, any City initiative, referendum or recall petition, intentionally fails to display in a font
16	and size that is clearly legible to the intended public an identification badge on his or her outermost
17	piece of clothing that includes the words "VOLUNTEER CIRCULATOR" if the person is not being paid
18	to circulate the petition or "PAID CIRCULATOR" if the person is being paid to circulate the petition.
