Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept and expend retroactively a grant from the World Health Organization (WHO) in the amount of \$22,566 to revise the document "Guide for HIV surveillance in low-level and concentrated epidemics;" for the period of June 15, 2009 through September 15, 2009.

WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from WHO in the amount of \$22,566 for a project entitled HIV Surveillance Guide; for the period of June 15, 2009 through September 15, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of this grant is to edit and revise the document "Guide for HIV surveillance in low-level and concentrated epidemics" according to new technical developments and experiences with the implementation of surveillance methodologies; and,

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not receive the required grant documents until May 27, 2009, while the project's start date is June 15, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds the World Health Organization requires DPH to enter into a Grant Agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>090946</u>, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses DPH for two existing positions: one Senior Physician Specialist, (Job Class 2232) at 0.20 FTE and one Health Program Coordinator III, (Job Class 2593) at 0.20 FTE for the period from June 15, 2009 through September 15, 2009; and,
