5 **2020, Consolidated General Election.**

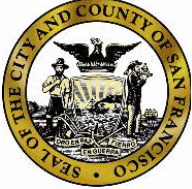

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter, Section 13.104.5, prohibits City employees and
8 officers (other than the Director of Elections, Department of Elections employees, Elections
9 Commissioners, the Sheriff and Sheriff’s Department employees) from performing “any
10 function relating to the conduct of an election;” and

11 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 13.104.5, authorizes the Board of Supervisors, upon the
12 request of the Elections Commission, to waive this prohibition by motion; and

13 WHEREAS, On September 16, 2020, the Elections Commission requested that the
14 Board of Supervisors waive this prohibition to permit City employees to assist the Department
15 of Elections with the November 3, 2020, election; now, therefore, be it

16 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter,
17 Section 13.104.5, to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections before,
18 during, and after the November 3, 2020, Consolidated General Election.
