3 **Resolution commending Daniel A. Sullivan for his years of contribution to the City and**
4 **County of San Francisco.**

6 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
7 commends Daniel A. Sullivan, a fourth generation San Franciscan, for his long and
8 distinguished commitment to serving the citizenry of San Francisco; and,

9 WHEREAS, In 1997, Mayor Willie L. Brown, Jr., appointed Daniel A. Sullivan to the
10 Mayor’s Citizen Committee on Community Development, in which he was elected Chair in
11 2003 and responsible for assessing community needs and prioritizing the allocation of funding
12 with the goal of increasing workforce development, affordable housing and economic
13 development; and,

14 WHEREAS, Daniel A. Sullivan currently serves as a Member of numerous community
15 and civic organizations including the Sunset Democratic Club, Democratic Women’s Forum,
16 Irish Democratic Club, State Democratic Committee and NAACP; and,

17 WHEREAS, Daniel A. Sullivan’s extensive public service career includes being a
18 elementary and secondary school teacher for the San Francisco Unified School District, a
19 police officer for the San Francisco Police Department, and a Firefighter - rising to the rank of
20 Assistant Deputy Chief for the San Francisco Fire Department; and,

21 WHEREAS, In 2002, Daniel A. Sullivan was appointed the Acting Executive Director of
22 San Francisco’s Emergency Communications Department; and,

23 WHEREAS, Daniel A. Sullivan has recently announced his retirement from public
24 service and will end his illustrious 28-year-career in public safety having efficiently managed

1 the day-to-day operation of all emergency and non-emergency calls, as well as the
2 dispatching of police, fire and emergency medical services; now, therefore, be it
