

1 AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN
2 FRANCISCO TO RETROACTIVELY APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS IN
3 THE AMOUNT OF \$110,110 MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL
4 JUSTICE PLANNING FOR A PROJECT ENTITLED "VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN
5 VERTICAL PROSECUTION - ELDER ABUSE" FOR THE PERIOD OF MARCH 1, 1999
6 THROUGH FEBRUARY 28, 2000; AND WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS DUE TO FUNDING
7 CONSTRAINTS;

8 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco desires to undertake a certain project
9 designated the Violence Against Women Vertical Prosecution Program - Elder Abuse to be funded
10 in part from funds made available through the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA), administered
11 by the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP); and
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13 WHEREAS, this project will investigate and vertically prosecute cases of violence, domestic
14 violence, and sexual assault against elderly women; now,

15 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District Attorney of the City and County of San
16 Francisco is authorized retroactively, on its behalf to submit the attached proposal to OCJP and is
17 authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the attached Grant
18 Award Agreement including any extension or amendments thereof except as any amendment would
19 increase any hard matching fund obligations of the City and County of San Francisco pursuant to
20 the contract; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the applicant agrees to provide all matching funds
23 required for said project under the program and the funding terms and conditions of OCJP and that
24 the cash match will be appropriated as required; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the

1 performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the
2 responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the Office of
3 Criminal Justice Planning disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
5 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

6 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the District Attorney of the City and
7 County of San Francisco is authorized to retroactively apply for, accept, and expend funds made
8 available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning for a project entitled "Violence Against
9 Women Vertical Prosecution Program - Elder Abuse" in the amount of \$110,110 for the twelve
10 month period March 1, 1999 through February 28, 2000, and waiving indirect cost due to funding
11 constraints.




