ENDORSING AMENDMENTS AND PROVIDING FINDINGS AS TO THE LOCAL

CONDITIONS SUPPORTING THOSE AMENDMENTS TO THE 1998 CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE, AS REQUIRED BY THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is enacting a Fire Code for the City and County of San Francisco to be known as the 1998 San Francisco Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, Some provisions of the 1998 San Francisco Fire Code are more restrictive than the 1998 California Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Sections 13143.5 and 18941.5 require the City to furnish reasons to the California Building Standards Commission for such deviations from the California Fire Code based upon local climatic, geological or topographical conditions; and

WHEREAS, Following are the local conditions justifying deviation from the 1998 California Fire Code:

Section 903.5. Geological - Due to the possibility of seismic events, additional water supplies need to be accessible for firefighting operations to supplement or substitute for normal water supply,

Section 1003.2.2.11. This Section is provided for informational purposes of Ordinance 938-93, which requires some existing high-rise buildings to install fire sprinkler protection.

This ordinance was based upon high seismic risk, wind conditions, and narrow lots which allow reasonable modifications to State Building Standards because of local climatic, geological or topographical conditions,

Section 1003.2.3.9. Topographical - Due to the difficulty of fire department access when fighting fires on piers, a fire suppression system is required to provide life safety protection,

Section 7904.6.8. Topographical - Due to the close proximity of buildings, which causes a high volume of people in business and residential areas, the Fire Marshall must have the authority to limit routes and times for vehicles transporting flammable and combustible liquids,

Section 8005. Topographical - Due to the close proximity of buildings which causes a high volume of people in business and residential areas, the Fire Marshal has authority to limit routes and times for vehicles transporting hazardous materials,

Section 9001.1.1. Geological and topographical - Due to the possibility of seismic events, more reliable water supplies are required for sprinkler systems in high-rise buildings. Additionally, due to topographical conditions, including the close proximity of other buildings to high-rise buildings, highly reliable sprinkler systems are necessary to protect high-rise buildings and the surrounding areas.

Section 9001.1.2. Geological and topographical - Due to the possibility of seismic events, additional water supplies need to be accessible for firefighting operations to supplement or substitute for normal water supply. Additionally, due to topographical conditions, including the close proximity of other buildings, to high-rise buildings highly reliable sprinkler systems are necessary to protect high-rise buildings and the surrounding areas.

Unless listed in the following, any amendments to the California Fire Code were for administrative, informational, or clarification purposes. Informational purposes consists of interpretations of the code requirements including supplemental rules and regulations in order to carry out the application and intent of the provisions as allowed in Section 101.4. Excluded from this list are any requirements, which are not promulgated by the State of California and not adopted by the State Fire Marshal; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby find and determine that the aforesaid changes to the 1998 San Francisco Fire Code are necessary because of the local

conditions set forth above; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the board of Supervisors is hereby directed to transmit this Resolution together with the 1998 San Francisco Fire Code to the California Building Standards Commission for filing, pursuant to the applicible provisions of state law.
