

1 [Changing Official Width of Sidewalk]

2 **Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled “Regulating the Width of**
3 **Sidewalks” by adding thereto Section No. 1565 to change the official**
4 **sidewalk widths on the easterly side of Waverly Place; making findings**
5 **pursuant to the General Plan and Planning Code Section 101.1; and**
6 **requiring relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected by the**
7 **sidewalk widths changes.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates
14 by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning
15 Department in its letter dated December 14, 2004, which stated that this project
16 is in conformity with the San Francisco General Plan. A copy of such letter is in
17 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. _____.

18 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works’ Order No.,
19 a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. _____,
20 Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled “Regulating the Width of
21 Sidewalks,” a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of
22 General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding
23 thereto a new section to read as follows:

24 Section 1565: The changing of official sidewalk widths on the
25 easterly side of Waverly Place shall be as shown on Department of Public Works
drawings Q-20-625 and Q-20-626 , a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board
of Supervisors File No._____.

1 Section 3. The Department of Public Works, as is necessary as a result of
2 this Ordinance, shall make arrangements with Public Utility companies and City
3 Departments for the relocation and/or adjustment of existing utility facilities in the
4 affected sidewalk and street areas. Any necessary relocation, modification, or
5 both of such facilities shall be at the cost to the City and County of San
6 Francisco.
