WHEREAS, The Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals is entrusted with upholding and enforcing federal law and the United States Constitution, and the lives and liberties of San Franciscans and other citizens of the United States greatly depend upon the Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals for fair interpretations and strong enforcement of federal law; and,

WHEREAS, Women and minority individuals particularly depend upon the Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals to insure that their rights are protected by Federal laws which include protections from racial discrimination, protection of reproductive services, protection of personal privacy, and to uphold federal laws that protect women and minorities from a wide range of serious inequities; and,

WHEREAS, Judge Carolyn Kuhl as an attorney, U.S. Justice

Department official, and Superior Court Judge, has a record of

limiting freedom of expression, failing to protect medical privacy,

advocating tax-exempt status for a racially discriminatory

institution, and attempting to reverse the landmark U.S. Supreme

Court decision in Roe vs. Wade; and,

WHEREAS, This record of opposition to Federal protections for women and minorities as well as opposition to reproductive freedom has established a clear precedent that indicates Judge Kuhl would stand opposed to many of the laws she would be entrusted with upholding on the Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals, and raises serious doubt that she would be an effective enforcer of these laws; and.

WHEREAS, Numerous national, state, and local organizations are in opposition to Judge Carolyn Kuhl's confirmation by the U.S. Senate including the California Abortion and Reproductive Rights Action League, Planned Parenthood Golden Gate, the Committee for Judicial Independence, the Lawyers Committee for Civil Rights, the National Center for Lesbian Rights, and the California chapter of the National Organization for Women; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, which has a diverse population of ethnic and cultural groups has a particular stake in the effective implementation of Federal Law as it pertains to civil rights; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges United States Senator Dianne Feinstein and United States Senator Barbara Boxer to oppose the confirmation of Judge Carolyn Kuhl to a seat on the Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals; and, be it
