4 **Motion appointing Vanessa Bohm, John Maa, Joi Jackson-Morgan (residency**
5 **requirement waived), Roberto Ariel Vargas (residency requirement waived), Johnathan**
6 **Butler (residency requirement waived), Janna Cordeiro and Derik Aoki, terms ending**
7 **December 31, 2020, to the Sugary Drinks Distributor Tax Advisory Committee.**

9 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
10 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Sugary Drinks
11 Distributor Tax Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Article
12 IV, Sections 5.20 and 5.21, for the terms specified:

13 Vanessa Bohm, seat 1, succeeding herself, term expired, must be held by a
14 representative of a nonprofit organization that advocate for health equity in communities that
15 are disproportionately impacted by diseases related to the consumption of sugar-sweetened
16 beverages, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 31, 2020.

17 John Maa, seat 2, succeeding Kent Woo, term expired, must be held by a
18 representative of a nonprofit organization that advocate for health equity in communities that
19 are disproportionately impacted by diseases related to the consumption of sugar-sweetened
20 beverages, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 31, 2020.

21 Joi Jackson-Morgan (residency requirement waived), seat 3, succeeding herself,
22 term expired, must be held by a representative of a nonprofit organization that advocate for
23 health equity in communities that are disproportionately impacted by diseases related to the
24 consumption of sugar-sweetened beverages, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term
25 ending December 31, 2020.

1 Roberto Ariel Vargas (residency requirement waived), seat 4, succeeding themselves, term expired, must be an individual who is employed at a medical institution in San Francisco
2 and who has experience in the diagnosis or treatment of, or in research or education about,
3 chronic and other diseases linked to the consumption of sugar-sweetened beverages, for the
4 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 31, 2020.

5 Jonathan Butler (residency requirement waived), seat 5, succeeding themselves, term
6 expired, must be an individual who is employed at a medical institution in San Francisco and
7 who has experience in the diagnosis or treatment of, or in research or education about,
8 chronic and other diseases linked to the consumption of sugar-sweetened beverages, for the
9 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 31, 2020.

10 Janna Cordeiro, seat 15, succeeding herself, term expired, must be a parent or
11 guardian of a student enrolled in the San Francisco Unified School District at the time of
12 appointment, nominated by the San Francisco Unified School District's Parent Advisory
13 Council, and appointed by the Board of Supervisors, for the unexpired portion of a two-year
14 term ending December 31, 2020.

15 Derik Aoki, seat 16, succeeding Lyra Ng, term expired, must be a person with
16 experience or expertise in services and programs for children five years old and under, for the
17 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending December 31, 2020.

18 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 19 1. The membership of the Sugary Drinks Distributor Tax Advisory Committee has a goal
20 to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 21 2. Applicants Joi Jackson-Morgan, Roberto Ariel Vargas, and Jonathan Butler, who are
22 not residents of San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies
23 them to serve on the Sugary Drinks Distributor Tax Advisory Committee.

1 3. The Sugary Drinks Distributor Tax Advisory Committee has attempted to fill the
2 positions, for which Joi Jackson-Morgan, Roberto Ariel Vargas, and Jonathan Butler
3 were nominated, with individuals who are City residents and who have the specific
4 experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The
5 Rules Committee has certified that Joi Jackson-Morgan, Roberto Ariel Vargas, and
6 Jonathan Butler, are qualified to serve on the Sugary Drinks Distributor Tax Advisory
7 Committee.

8 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no
9 other possible representatives, who are residents of San Francisco, and who have the
10 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and who
11 are willing to serve on the Sugary Drinks Distributor Tax Advisory Committee at this
12 time; and, be it

13 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
14 for Joi Jackson-Morgan, Roberto Ariel Vargas, and Jonathan Butler, as allowed in cases
15 where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section
16 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies
17 established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and
18 County of San Francisco.
