12 grant entitled "Social Movements and HIV/AIDS in Brazil", which includes funds in the
13 amount of \$16,431 for work on this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Subgrantee has agreed to participate in this grant, as described
16 in the joint CU-Subgrantee proposal submitted to the National Science Foundation; and

17 WHEREAS, CU as the primary contractor has requested that the Subgrantee
18 enter into a subcontract to participate in this project by assisting in coordination,
19 developing data collection instruments, maintaining data quality assurance, and
20 coordinating data analysis; and,

22 WHEREAS, CU has agreed to reimburse the Subgrantee in the amount of
23 \$16,431 under the terms of this subcontract; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$2,266; now, therefore, be it


