

1 [Contract funds to evaluate the integration of buprenorphine treatment into the SFGH AIDS  
2 Program, Year 1.]

4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Community**  
5 **Behavioral Health Services (SFDPH, CBHS), to enter retroactively into the first year of**  
6 **an agreement with the University of California San Francisco (UCSF), the primary**  
7 **contractor, and expend funds in the amount of \$52,190 to provide local and multi-site**  
8 **evaluation of the integration of buprenorphine treatment into the SFGH AIDS Program;**  
9 **for the period of September 1, 2004 to August 31, 2005.**

11 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the Department of Health and  
12 Human Services, National Institutes of Health, for a program titled, Integrating Buprenorphine  
13 into the SFGH AIDS Programs; and,

14

15 WHEREAS, UCSF and SFDPH,CBHS have agreed to enter into a subcontract  
16 agreement to participate in this project; and,

17

18 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH,CBHS in the amount of \$52,190  
19 from this award under the terms for Year 1 of this subcontract agreement; and,

20

21 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, UCSF requires SFDPH,CBHS to  
22 enter into an agreement (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the  
23 Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of  
24 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

26 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$4,190;  
27 and,

28

29 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors  
30 because we did not receive the subcontract until March 22, 2005; and,

1           WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds  
2 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually  
3 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure  
4 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

5           RESOLVED, That SFDPH,CBHS is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a Year  
6 1 subcontract agreement in the amount of \$52,190 with UCSF, the primary contractor; and, be  
7 it

8           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
9 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

10          FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when  
12 the agreement expires.
