ENACTING AND RESCINDING PARKING REGULATIONS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS.

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the parking of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

NO PARKING ANYTIME - RESCIND

Jessie Street, north side, from 7th Street to westerly terminus

RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "I" (1-HOUR TIME LIMIT, 9 AM - 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY) - ESTABLISH

22nd Street, both sides, between South Van Ness Avenue and Shotwell Street (westerly portion of 3000 block)

Shotwell Street, both sides, between 21st and 22nd Streets (700 block)

RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "L" (2-HOUR TIME LIMIT, 8 AM - 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY) - ESTABLISH

Emerson Street, both sides, from Geary Boulevard to the north terminus (unit block)

TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 3 PM - 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY - ESTABLISH

North Point Street, north side, from 80 feet to 155 feet east of Stockton Street (75-foot zone)
