



From 2010 until 2013, she served as the United States Ambassador to Hungary, appointed by President Barack Obama. During her service, Ambassador Kounalakis received two Meritorious Honor awards, and was nominated by her staff for a the Susan M. Cobb award for distinguished diplomatic service.

Currently, Ambassador Kounalakis holds a non-resident fellowship at the U.S. Department of State. She is a Senior Advisor at Albright Stonebridge Group, and serves as chair of the California Advisory Council for International Trade and Investment. She also serves as a member of the board of the UC Berkeley Haas School of Business, where she received her MBA in 1992. She holds an Honorary Doctorate of Laws from the American College of Greece.
