8	021606, opposing the subcontracting of custodial services at the new Mission Bay Campus,
9	WHEREAS, UCSF Mission Bay will ultimately need an estimated 600 service workers;

11	WHEREAS, UCSF has worked tirelessly to create a staffing plan that satisfies both the
12	needs of UCSF and AFSCME; and,
13	WHEREAS, Under the agreement struck between UCSF and AFSCME, UCSF has
14	agreed not to subcontract custodians, groundskeepers, parking attendant, food service, and
15	other AFSCME-represented workers; and,
16	WHEREAS, The agreement between UCSF and AFSCME covers the entire Mission
17	Bay project through all phases of the build out; now, therefore, be it
18	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
19	commends the University of California San Francisco (UCSF) for working with the American
20	Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) to resolve labor issues
21	surrounding the future Mission Bay Campus.
