CONCURRING WITH THE CONTROLLER'S CERTIFICATION THAT INTAKE AND SHELTER SERVICES TO STATUS OFFENDERS CAN BE PRACTICALLY PERFORMED BY PRIVATE CONTRACTOR FOR LOWER COST THAN SIMILAR WORK SERVICES PERFORMED BY CITY AND COUNTY EMPLOYEES; RETROACTIVE TO JULY 1, 1998.

WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition "J" in November 1976, adding Section 8.300-1 to the Charter allowing City departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can be practically performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and County employees; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department seeks to renew a contract with Huckleberry Youth Program a San Francisco non-profit youth serving agency and wishes to contract for intake and shelter service to status offenders, and

WHEREAS, the Controller has certified that said services will be performed at lower cost to the City and County than by employees of the City and County; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board Of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's certification and approves that the Juvenile Probation Department may contract for intake and shelter services to status offenders for fiscal year 1998-99; retroactive to July 1, 1998.
