WHEREAS, The resulting Critical Teacher Shortage in these programs is seriously eroding the educational Quality of these State funded centers for low income, limited English speaking and special needs children; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors SB 993, the Early Education and Wage Equity Act of 2001 introduced by Senator Liz Figueroa; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That The Board of Supervisors urges the Legislature to pass the Early Education and Wage Equity Act; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That The Board of Supervisors urges Governor Davis to sign the Early Education and Wage Equity Act and include this legislation in his campaign to improve school success and strengthen the long-term economic well being of California and its future workers.
