9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending  
11 Section 21.5(e), to read as follows:

12 SEC. 21.5. OTHER PURCHASES.

13 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, procurement of the following shall  
14 be made in accordance with the Purchaser's regulations:

15 (a) Commodities or services where the total amount of the purchase does not exceed  
16 \$50,000.

17 (b) Commodities or services available only from a sole source.

18 (c) Perishable foods.

19 (d) Proprietary articles.

20 (e) Contracts involving a pilot project with a term not to exceed two years; provided,  
21 however, that any further procurement beyond the pilot project phase shall be subject to all  
22 applicable competitive procurement requirements.

23 (f) The Purchaser may designate a particular Solicitation as a small business set  
24 aside, and restrict competition for that contract to DBEs. Such set-aside shall not continue for  
25 more than two consecutive years for any particular contract, and the Purchaser shall not

1 allocate an aggregate of more than ten million dollars per fiscal year for DBE set-aside  
2 contracts. The findings made by the Board of Supervisors with respect to contracting with  
3 local businesses in Administrative Code Section 12-D.A.2 are hereby incorporated by  
4 reference into this section.

5 (1) The Municipal Transportation Agency is authorized to implement new  
6 and continue existing on-street parking meter and parking control pilot projects under the SFPark  
7 Program for a total term not to exceed forty-nine months. This subsection (1) shall expire on July 1,  
8 2012. The City Attorney shall take such steps as are necessary to have this subsection (1) removed  
9 from this Code at that time.

10 (g) Commodities or Services purchased with federal grant funds, awarded for the  
11 purpose of enhancing security and overall preparedness to prevent, respond to, or recover  
12 from acts of terrorism, where the total amount of the purchase does not exceed \$100,000.  
13 Federal grant funds include federal monies awarded to the City through the state or other  
14 governmental entities. This subsection does not cover Commodities or Services identified by  
15 the grant as an administrative or management cost or expense.
