7 8	RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "H" (2-HOUR TIME LIMIT, 8 AM - 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY) - ESTABLISH
9	21 st Avenue, both sides, between Ocean Avenue and Sloat Boulevard (2900 block); and
1	Sloat Boulevard, south side, between 20th and 21st Avenues (400 block).
2	RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "Z" (2-HOUR TIME LIMIT, 8 AM - 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY) - ESTABLISH
3 4	21st Street, both sides, between Dolores and Guerrero Streets (3400 block).
5	RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "U" (2HOUR TIME LIMIT, 8 AM - 10 PM, EVERYDAY) - ESTABLISH
6 7	248-254 Ritch Street, west side, between Brannan and Bryant Streets (adds even addresses only, no permit parking signs will be posted on this block).
8	PARKING METER AREA NO. 3 (9 AM - 6PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY) -
9	<u>ESTABLISH</u>
20	Bacon Street, north side, from San Bruno Avenue to 135 feet easterly.
21	TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME - RESCIND
22	Bacon Street, north side, from 125 to 135 feet east of San Bruno Avenue.
23	UNMETERED MOTORCYCLE PARKING - ESTABLISH
24 25	Plum Street, north side, from Mission Street to 31 feet easterly (31-foot zone, accommodating 5 motorcycle parking spaces).
