

1 [Concurring in Declaration of Local Emergency - Flooding Affecting SFPUC's Moccasin
2 Reservoir (Tuolumne County)]

3 **Motion concurring in the March 29, 2018, Declaration of Local Emergency by the Mayor**
4 **and in the actions taken to meet the emergency of flooding affecting the San Francisco**
5 **Public Utilities Commission's Moccasin Reservoir in Tuolumne County.**

7 WHEREAS, On March 29, 2018, Mayor Mark E. Farrell declared a local emergency to
8 exist in connection with flooding caused by a high intensity rain storm on March 22, 2018 in
9 the vicinity of the town of Moccasin in Tuolumne County; on March 22, 2018, a total of five
10 inches of rain fell that afternoon, causing a large flow of water and debris from Moccasin
11 Creek to enter the SFPUC's Moccasin Reservoir, flooding nearby areas and causing damage
12 to SFPUC property and equipment, including Moccasin Dam; the flooding has also impacted
13 the water delivery conveyance capability from the Hetch Hetchy system to the SFPUC's
14 Regional Water system; and

15 WHEREAS, The Mayor does hereby find that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril
16 justify and require a proclamation of the existence of a local emergency; and

17 WHEREAS, The Mayor has transmitted a copy of that Declaration of Local Emergency
18 to the Board of Supervisors, and such copy is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
19 Supervisors in File No. 180293; and,

20 WHEREAS, The Mayor has directed the head of each department and agency to
21 observe his or her proper relationship in the command structure of the Incident Command
22 System, and be responsive to the orders and requests of the Lead Department designated to
23 exercise supervision over his or her department during the course of this emergency; and

24 WHEREAS, The Governor of the State of California is hereby requested to include the
25 area of the City of the City and County of San Francisco in any emergency declaration by the

1 State, and is further requested to ensure that the City and County of San Francisco is
2 included in any emergency declaration that may be issued by the President of the United
3 States; and

4 WHEREAS, This declaration of a local emergency shall be deemed to continue until it
5 is terminated by the Mayor or the Board of Supervisors; all departments of the City and
6 County of San Francisco are strictly enjoined to cooperate with the requests for material and
7 personnel resources by the Incident Command System staff of said City and County which is
8 located in the Emergency Operations Center of the City and County of San Francisco; now,
9 therefore, be it

10 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with the Declaration of Local
11 Emergency issued by the Mayor on March 29, 2018, and in the actions taken by the Mayor to
12 meet the emergency.


