

1 [Improve the system of care for seriously mentally ill residents of San Francisco, including
2 services for those with a dual disorder of mental illness and substance abuse.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH),**
5 **Community Mental Health Services (CMHS), to accept retroactively and expend federal**
6 **SAMHSA Mental Health Block Grant funds in the total amount of \$3,198,952 from the**
7 **State Department of Mental Health (SDMH) to improve the system of care for seriously**
8 **emotionally disturbed children and severely mentally ill adults in San Francisco,**
9 **including those with a diagnosis of a dual disorder of mental illness and substance**
10 **abuse; for the period of July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2002.**

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12 WHEREAS, SFDPH, CMHS has an existing FY 01-02 SAMHSA Mental Health Block
13 Grant of \$1,939,394, and a \$573,737 carry forward from FY 00-01, and has applied for and
14 been awarded new one-time grant dollars and additional on-going grant dollars from SDMH in
15 the amount of \$685,821 for the period of January 1, 2002 to June 30, 2002 to expand dual
16 disorder treatment capacity; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the additional grant funds, SDMH required
18 SFDPH CMHS to submit a revised expenditure plan for Fiscal Year 01-02 SAMHSA
19 Community Mental Health Block Grant funds in the amount of \$3,198,952, a copy of which is
20 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 012259, which is hereby declared
21 to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That SFDPH CMHS is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and
25 expend a grant in the amount of \$3,198,952, from SDMH; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH CMHS is hereby authorized to accept and
2 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170 ; and,
3 be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
5 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller should be urged to designate the positions
7 funded under the grant as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when the
8 grant expires.
